On Friday, December 21, 2007, at 0913 hrs. myself and Lt. Pete Fisher were advised to respond to the address of 270 Kopchak Rd. the residence of Terry Thompson. Sheriff Bob Stephenson had received a phone call from a Muskingum County resident advising of horses on Terry Thompson's farm being malnourished and not taken care of. With that being said myself and Lt. Fisher responded to the address to investigate.

As we pulled into the property of Terry Thompson we noticed a large amount of horses spread out on the acreage.

From what I could visually see from the distance of the horses in my patrol car they seemed to be cared for and in good health. As we pulled up to the barn area where Terry has some of his animals stored, there was a black Chevy or GMC truck blocking the remainder of the road. In the back of the vehicle I could easily observe several deer carcasses in the bed of the pickup. As I walked further in front of the pickup truck I also observed several large carcasses of dead cattle behind that vehicle. The smell of rotting flesh was very hard to stand.

As I made my way up the driveway to the residence with Lt. Fisher we tried several doors attempting to make contact with either Terry or his spouse.

We also had Dispatch try the phone number listed for Terry Thompson and we could not receive any answer.

Lt. Fisher left a message with the Game Warden to advise him of some of the sights we had observed while on the property.

Beulah Hauge was also was also contacted in reference to this incident, but apparently contact was not made with her and a message was left.

With no one at the residence to assist us with the complaint we are investigating myself and Lt. Fisher departed from property.

This will conclude this report.

On Sunday, July 15, 2007, at 2314 hrs. myself and DEP. LAWHORNE responded to the area of S. Rehl Rd. and the West Pike, in reference to horses in the roadway.

Upon my arrival to that intersection I was unable to locate the horses, so I did continue to patrol the area, when I did observe in the area of 2550 S. Rehl Rd. approx. 7 brown horses and one smaller horse on the east side of the roadway of S. Rehl Rd. I did stop my patrol cruiser and get out and the horses then did take off running through the field towards the West Pike area. I did advise Dep. Lawhorne who had pulled up behind me that the horses appeared to be going towards the West Pike, so he then did take position on the West Pike to make sure that the horses did not enter the roadway of the West Pike and became a traffic hazard.

Dep. Lawhorne did radio me and advise me that TERRY THOMPSON was on the West Pike near this location and was headed towards the 2550 S. Rehl Rd. address responding to my location.

Upon making contact with Terry Thompson, he advised me that he had gone out to feed the horses and found that they were missing. He then began looking for them and found that they were here just as we did.

Terry advised me that he was going to attempt to coral the horses from the field just east of the 2550 S. Rehl Rd. address and they had crossed the roadway of S. Rehl Rd. onto the property of 2550 S. Rehl Rd. and then onto his property.

I then did go approx. 2 houses south and positioned my patrol vehicle in the roadway so that no one would pass through when the horses were coming through. After a few moments Terry Thompson did coral the horses and they did block the roadway in front of 2550 S. Rehl Rd. and then he did get the animals back onto his property.

Before parting with Terry Thompson I did advise Terry that I was going to issue him a citation for his animals being at large with a court date of Friday, July 20, 2007, at 0900 hrs.

Terry Thompson was very cooperative and did sign the bottom of the citation which he was given a copy of the citation and advised of his court date.

On Sunday, 11/26/06 at approx. 1759 hrs. I was dispatched to go to 2480 South River Road in reference to a bull being in this subject's pasture field, believed to be coming over from Terry Thompson's property.

I arrived at 1812 hrs. and spoke with the comp. RICK MILLER. Rick stated that there is a Brahma bull that keeps coming over on his property here for the past two weeks. This bull keeps coming over from the back part of that property and keeps damaging his fence and coming through a gate that is closed. He states the bull pushes his way right through.

He stated there is no damage this time when the bull has come through but he has done in the past. He states that he is afraid that his heifers are going to be bred by this Brahma bull because he does not want that because he has an Angus here that does that for him. Rick states he just wants Mr. Thompson to keep his animals on his property, that he is tired of them coming over here. He stated this happens all the time of the bull or horses coming over here. He stated that he just wants Mr. Thompson to keep his animals over on his property. Rick stated that he just wants the bull kept out of here if he possibly can and not over here.

I then cleared from Rick Miller's residence. I did try to contact Terry Thompson by a phone call and was unsuccessful. I then cleared the call. End of supplement.

On today's date of 12/05/06 I was dispatched to the original complainant's address of 2480 S. Rehl Rd. in reference to the same animal still out and still on his property.

Upon arrival I did see the animal in question being approximately 2000 lb. white and gray Brahma Bull. Upon my arrival the bull was in fact in a general yard area of the property and was not in any type of fence.

Upon speaking with Mr. Miller the complainant he advised that the animal is still here and has been since the last time Dep. Gearhart was here for the report and he wants the animal gone. He advised the animal is causing him financial hardship as it is eating the feed and breeding his animals who he does not want breed by that particular animal. Mr. Miller advises that the Brahma Bull is impossible to keep anywhere, most of the time it opens its own gate or goes through barb wire fence. He advises that he has been charged by the bull and described it as aggressive.

Attempt was made to contact the owner of the bull Mr. Terry Thompson. All I got was an answering machine. At that time I left a message approximately 20 after 6 this date p.m. advising Mr. Thompson to come get the bull or we would have to remove it ourselves.

Approximately 7:40 p.m. this date I made contact with Mr. Thompson's voice mail again. This time I left message indicating to him that we now have the animal and that he should contact us in reference to having it returned. Shortly after Mr. Lantz left with the animal I received a phone call from Mr. Thompson. During the course of that conversation Mr. Thompson advised that he would be willing to make a civil agreement and pay Mr. Lantz for transporting the animal and he would like to have the animal returned back to his residence on Kopchak Rd. Mr. Lantz agreed and I assisted Mr. Lantz with a standby as the animal was returned to Mr. Thompson.

On Friday, November 10, 2006, around 1437 hrs., I was dispatched to go to 2460 S. Rehl Road, in reference to horses in her field.

When I had arrived there I did observe two horses and a donkey standing in a side field at 2460 S. Rehl Road, at which time I did go up to try and make contact at the residence there. An older female did come to the door stating that the homeowners are not here that they did go to the back that they will be back later.

This female who was there at 2460 S. Rehl Road at this time stated that these horses she does know has been here for the past three days, they just keep coming and leaving as they wish. She stated that they are always over here in the field beside the house or the one across the road.

After telling that female that I am going to try and locate the owner of these horses and that I will be back later to talk to the homeowners I did take photographs of the two horses and the one donkey which was in the field. There was a white horse, a black horse and one donkey.

After taking the photographs, I then did go over to 270 Kopchak Road, which is the residence of TERRY THOMPSON. I had arrived there at that location around 1500 hrs. when I arrived there I did see a gentleman on a four wheeler riding up to me on the driveway there. He identified himself to me as Terry Thompson, at which time I asked him if he knew he had a couple of animals loose. He stated yes, that he was just about ready to go over there and get them, at which time I advised him that they are in the field across from the oil well road there on South Rehl Road.

Terry Thompson advised me that he would be in route over to that location to get these animals. At that time I did leave from 270 Kopchak Road and went back over to 2550 S. Rehl in the driveway there. The horses were in the field across from this location. Terry Thompson arrived over there approx. around 1517 hrs.

When Mr. Thompson arrived over there I asked him again if his horses can get out very easily. He stated that he does have an electric fence and a second fence, but the second fence is knocked down that it has been knocked down for quite sometime that when they logged the back part of the property a tree had fell on the fence and knocked it over, so the only thing keeping these animals in is an electric fence, but they can jump over it very easily was what Mr. Thompson had told me.

I asked him where he has been all day. He stated that he was out of town, he

was in New Hope that he had just returned prior to my arrival.

Mr. Thompson also advised me that it was impossible for these animals to have been over here for three days. I asked him if he has seen them in the past three days. He did not answer me. He just told me that the white horse is 34 yrs. old and that the donkey had probably led them over here. He stated that it is a nice day and that is probably why they strayed from the residence there.

He then told me that he would take these animals back to his property and place them in the barn for tonight.

He stated again that these animals are inside two fences, but one fence is knocked down. He stated that the inside fence is an electric fence, but they could possibly jump it. At that time Mr. Thompson took his animals back on a trail over to the property. After he had taken his horse I then cleared there at 1520 hrs.

I did go back over to the complainant's residence at 2037 hrs. at which time I spoke to a CARRIE FRAME.

Carrie had stated to me that the past three days these horses have been over here on her side of the property in the field that they just graze in the field and eat her apples. She stated that she really does not believe that they tear up much, but it is just a nuisance always having them over there.

She is scared that someone might hit the horse and get seriously injured. She would like to see Mr. Thompson put up fences all the way around his property so these horses can not get out.

She stated that this has been going on or quite sometime with the horses always coming over on a daily basis.

Carrie did state that today is the first day she has seen the donkey over here. Usually there are big black horses or even this white one has been over here before. She states that they just come over graze in the field and stay for several hours. She stated that they either stay in her field beside the residence or the one across the street. She said that she even sees them going up the oil well road there at S. Rehl and St. Rt. 40 sometimes.

Carrie states that she hates to call us on this, but she does not want to see anyone get injured by hitting a horse or some sort of animal because of his negligence of not properly putting up fences. I then asked Carrie if there was anything else, she told me no.

On 10/25/06 approx. 4:20 AM I was dispatched to 2060 Quincy Road in Zanesville in reference to an animal complaint. Dispatch advised that the comp. stated to the effect that she had two horses and a donkey in her yard.

Upon arriving at the residence I did see two horses and a donkey in the front yard of the residence. One horse was brown with some white. The other was black and white and the donkey was brown with white.

The comp. met me outside of the residence and stated to the effect that she was getting ready to leave for work and she noticed that the motion activated outside spot light was on. The comp. went on to state that she looked outside to see what activated the light and saw the animals in her front yard. The comp. also stated that she has seen horses in the area frequently and that this is not the first time that they have been in her yard. The comp. said that on some mornings when she was driving down south Rehl Road towards SR 40, she has almost hit the horses because they have been in the road.

The comp. also stated that there was no damage to her yard. The horses and donkey were not causing any problems.

I did ask the comp. if anyone in the area had horses and she stated the only person that lives anywhere near that area that has any type of animals such as horses or donkeys or any other types of animals that size is TERRY THOMPSON.

Attempts were made to contact Terry Thompson with no answer. Also messages were not returned.

Also no other individuals were able to be located to take possession of the animals until we could make contact with and determine the owner of these animals.

After speaking to the comp. while patrolling the area, another dark colored, almost black in appearance horse did run in front of my patrol car. This was on South Rehl Road approx. a quarter of a mile from SR 40. This horse did run from a field and was coming from the direction of Kopchak Road, ran across the road to the east and into a wooded area and was unable to be located.

It should also be noted that the animals at the 2060 Quincy Road while there

CARRIE FRAME

When I spoke with Carrie, I advised that her corn stalks, straw bales and potted mums as well as some decorative lights at the end of her driveway appeared to have been damaged by the two horses and the donkey. She explained that this is a frequent problem that the horses and donkey are in her yard almost daily, however she does not contact anyone as long as they are not harming her property.

Carrie stated she does not feel that she or any of the neighbors should have to live with someone else's livestock in their yard. She did advise that previous damage by the two horses and donkey included, several apple trees that are now damaged and some had died because of the severe damage by the livestock.

I obtained from her the cost of the decorative items that had been damaged by the animals and advised her to contact our office if the animals were loose and in her yard again. She advised that she was trying to be neighborly by not calling every single day when they are out but if it's going to be a continual problem she will begin making phone calls.

Myself and Dep. Swartz stayed in the area trying to maintain the two horses and donkey so that they would not enter the roadway and cause a traffic hazard. We were later advised that after several minutes that Terry Thompson had been contacted and was enroute to our location.

Upon his arrival, he immediately exited his vehicle and began yelling to the horses by name, Rusty and Smoky and attempted to tget then to follow him up a back path from South Rehl to the rear of his property. However the horses and donkey were not cooperating.

After several minutes of chasing them around the neighborhood and soforth, Mr. Thompson got them to return to his property. He then advised me that the two horses and donkey had been contained in the barn over night and had busted down a gate allowing them to exit and leave his property unbeknownst to him until his contact with our office on the today's date.

At this time no further follow up is necessary. End of report.

On Thursday, May 25, 2006, at approx. 11:30 a.m. I was dispatched to the area of I-70 off ramp and on ramp at mm 152, in reference to horses in the roadway. Upon my arrival at 1138 hrs. there were 5 horses, one full size horse the other 4 appeared to be ponies, running up and down the westbound on ramp to I-70. There were vehicle stopped along he on ramp along 40 and traffic was backed up due to the horses running along the on ramp. I blocked the on ramp with my cruiser so no other cars would be able to pull onto the onramp.

As I got out of my car I did see TERRY THOMPSON, who is the owner of the horses, trying to round them up. He did have one lead rope on the full size horse and he had a pony by the halter. He was walking these 2 down the on ramp towards 40. As he went by me I asked him what he is doing with them. He stated that he was going to walk them back down the onramp walk them along 40 up South Rehl and taking them back in where they are getting out. I asked him what about the other 3 ponies that were still running around. He said that they would follow. He started to walk down the onramp, but the other three ponies were not following him. He did get HOD BRENNAN who was a witness and was standing there to hold the 2 horses that he already had while he went back and tried to round up the other 3. He was able to get the other 3 to follow him in the direction of St. Rt. 40.

He then got the horses from Mr. Brennan and then walked down the on ramp. Once he got to 40 the horses did walk along side him on 40. I did have to use my patrol car to block off St. Rt. 40 so that no vehicles could come up behind them as the 3 ponies that were running loose were walking in both lanes of St. Rt. 40 eastbound even though he was walking the 2 horses he had along the edge of the roadway.

The 3 horses that were running loose eventually took off running from Mr. Thompson. They did run right up the middle of St. Rt. 40, they did run up South Rehl Road on their own and went back into the field where they got out at.

Mr. Thompson walked the other 2 up South Rehl himself and put them back in the fence. I was there for approx. 11 minutes with the road shut down due to the horses running loose in the roadway. The call came in at 11:30 so the horse were running loose for approx. 20 minutes that we know of along the road. This is not the first time that we had been called out there in reference to Mr. Thompson's horses running loose and Mr. Thompson stated that the horses keep getting out in the same spot yet he refuses to fix the fence.

On May 16, 2006 our office received another incident of a horse running eastbound in the westbound lane of St. Rt. 40.

Dep. Hamilton, Dep. Barnes, Sgt. Keck and Lt. Wilson were all dispatched to that incident.

Back on March 8, 2006 I was dispatched to South Rehl Road, in reference to horses running loose in the area and when I arrived on that incident the horses were no longer in the road causing a road hazard, but were grazing in another individuals field and we did leave a message on Terry Thompson's machine for him to round up his horses.

Due to all the recent incident's of Mr. Thompson's horses getting out and running loose in the roadway causing road hazards, I feel that charges need to be filed against Mr. Thompson and maybe he would get his fence fixed then so that they would stop getting out.

He stated that he was driving his wrecker on St. Rt. 40 and he was heading in towards town so he was going eastbound. He stated that as he was getting near the I-70 underpass there were 5 horses running towards him on St. Rt. 40. He stated that they were heading westbound in the eastbound lane.

He stated that there were vehicles behind him so he immediately slowed down and tried to block traffic. He stated that he got out of his truck and was trying to round the horses up to get them off of the roadway before a bad accident happened.

He stated that he did not chase after them he just tried to block the roadway so that they could not go any further. However, they started going in all different directions and they ended up going up the on ramp to I-70.

He stated that before he knew it there were cars parked all along the roadway, people were all out running around trying to catch the horses. Hod stated that this was a very bad situation and that there could have been a serious accident with these horses getting loose.
